Numerous trees were down, limbs were ripped away and scattered everywhere and debris was spread out across most of the area. We became depressed that the shelterees would be right...a home left in shambles.

As my headlights hit our house, we were completely shocked. Aside from some skirting around the base blown away, our Nobility Home was completely and totally intact! Not a single piece of siding was missing or ripped, not a pane of glass cracked or blown out, and not one shingle out of place. The Hazel stood her ground with pride, and she was a MOST welcome sight! We were prepared for the worst, hoped for the best, and our hopes became reality. All this, in the shadow of the strongest hurricane to ever come out of the Atlantic basin, and a tornado she spawned to boot.
